# New Residential Building Permit

# **Application Requirements**

All New Residential location improvement applications shall be accompanied by an accurate set of blue prints and an accurate drawing or a plot plan to scale.

### Blue prints shall include at a minimum, but not be limited to:

- 1. Specification sheet. (Necessary information not found on plan sheets)
  - General notes
  - Insulation details
  - Design Loads & material information
  - Foundation details/notes
  - Electrical details/notes
  - HVAC details/notes
  - Plumbing details/notes
  - Door & window details/location
- 2. Elevation drawing (front & side)
- 3. Foundation plan
- 4. Floor plan (all floors)
- 5. Electrical plan & legend
- 6. Wall section
- 7. Floor framing
- 8. Roof framing
- 9. Truss design (if applicable)

### Site drawing or plot plan shall include at a minimum, but not be limited to:

- 1. Location of the right-of-way line or lines adjoining highways, streets, alleys, and easements.
- 2. The lot or plot and dimensions.
- 3. Existing structures (location and size).
- 4. Proposed location of construction on lot or plot.
- 5. Accurate dimensions of proposed construction.
- 6. Accurate dimensions of proposed construction in relation to property boundaries.
- 7. Proposed location of sewage disposal systems and water supply source.
- 8. Parking area.

### **Additional Information:**

- 1. A signed Energy Certificate demonstrated compliance with current Indiana Energy Code Requirements.
- 2. If a building is within the Municipal Boundary of the Town of Mooresville an Erosion & Sediment Control Plan will need to be provided.

- 3. If a building lot within the Municipal Boundary of the Town of Mooresville is greater than 10,000 sq. ft. an Erosion Control Permit will need to be obtained.
- 4. If a building is located in the Town of Mooresville Buffer Zone a copy of an exemption letter or Stormwater Permit will need to be provided from the Morgan County Surveyor's Office.
- 5. A copy of the sewer permit (Town of Mooresville) or septic permit (Morgan County Health Department)
- 6. A street cut permit is required if any type of work is to be on the public right-of-ways
- 7. Approval must be obtained from the Town of Mooresville if plans are to alter any natural or man-made drainage system.
- 8. Before a building permit can be issued in the buffer zone, a permit for the driveway must be obtained from the Morgan County Plan Commission.
