
Project Basics

- SR 42/High Street from White Lick Creek Bridge to SR 67
- Project Needs
 - Deteriorating pavement condition
 - Lack of ADA accessibility
 - Safety concerns at High Street intersections with Monroe Street, Franklin Street and South Street.
- Project Scope
 - Pavement rehabilitation
 - Replace curbs
 - Add curb ramps
 - Add shared-use trail along north side



Schedule

- Survey Completed December 2017
- Initial Project Planning Completed January 2018
- Preliminary Design December 2018
- Environmental Document February 2019
- Right of Way Procurement February 2019 to August 2020

NextLevel

- Final Design June 2020
- Bidding December 2020
- Construction January 2021 to November 2021
 - Utilities may start their relocations in Fall 2020
 - Sodding and planting work may continue into 2022



South Street Intersection Options





Option #1

- Prohibit left turns from SR 42
 onto South Street
- Prohibit left turns from South Street onto SR 42
- Advantage = Safest option
- Disadvantage = Left turning traffic will need to find an alternate route

Option #2

- Prohibit left turns from South Street onto SR 42
- Create right turn lane from SR 42 onto South Street
- Advantage = Continues to allow for left turns off SR 42
- Disadvantage = Reduces length of right turn lane approaching SR 67
