

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF MOORESVILLE,  
INDIANA ON PROPOSED STREET NAME CHANGE ORDINANCE –  
W HARRISON STREET / HARRISON AVENUE EAST**

The Town Council of the Town of Mooresville, Morgan County, Indiana (the "Town Council") will conduct a public hearing on April 7, 2026, at 6:30 p.m. (Local Time) at the Government Center located at 4 E. Harrison St., Mooresville, Indiana 46158, to consider an ordinance amending the Official Street Name Map of the Town of Mooresville, Indiana (the "Ordinance").

The Ordinance proposes to rename the segment of the L-shaped public roadway presently designated as "Harrison Avenue East" to "W Harrison Street" such that the entire L-shaped roadway connecting W Main Street to S Monroe Street shall be known and officially designated as "W Harrison Street." The Ordinance is designed to address inconsistent naming of this single continuous roadway that has caused confusion for delivery drivers, the United States Postal Service, and other service providers, and has the potential to hinder or delay the response of emergency services. The proposed name change will promote clarity in addressing, improve public safety, and serve the best interests of the residents of Mooresville.

A copy of the Ordinance is on file and available for inspection at the office of the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Mooresville, located at 4 E. Harrison St., Mooresville, Indiana 46158, during regular business hours. At the public hearing, the Town Council will receive and hear comments and objections from interested persons concerning the proposed Ordinance and the street name change described above.
